

Cookies

The First-tier Tribunal (Immigration and Asylum Chamber) form/s puts small files (known as 'cookies') onto your computer to collect information about how you browse the site.

Cookies are used to:

- remember your progress
- measure how you use the website so it can be updated and improved based on your needs

First-tier Tribunal (Immigration and Asylum Chamber) cookies aren't used to identify you personally.

You'll normally see a message on the site before we store a cookie on your computer.

How cookies are used on First-tier Tribunal (Immigration and Asylum Chamber)

We will store a cookie to remember your application progress in this computer and to expire your session after 30 minutes of inactivity or when you close your browser.

Name	Purpose	Expires
_sessionId	Saves your current progress in this computer and tracks inactivity periods	After 30 minutes of inactivity or when you close your browser

Measuring website usage (Google Analytics)

We use Google Analytics software to collect information about how you use First-tier Tribunal (Immigration and Asylum Chamber). We do this to help make sure the online form is meeting the needs of its users and to help us make improvements. Google Analytics stores information about:

- the pages you visit
- how long you spend on each page
- how you got to the site
- what you click on while you're visiting the site

We do not collect or store your personal information (for example your name or address) so this information can't be used to identify who you are.

We do not allow Google to use or share our analytics data.

Google Analytics sets the following cookies:

Name	Purpose	Expires

_ga	This helps us count how many people visit Claim for costs of a child's funeral	2 years
_gid	This helps us count how many people visit Claim for costs of a child's funeral	24 hours
_gat	Used to manage the rate at which page view requests are made	10 minutes

Google Analytics

Name	Purpose	Expires
_utma	Like _ga, this lets us know how many of our visitors are new to Claim for costs of a child's funeral or to a certain page	2 years
_utmb	This works with _utmc to calculate the average length of time you spend on Claim for costs of a child's funeral	30 minutes

_utmc	This works with _utmb to calculate when you close your browser	when you close your browser
_utmz	This tells us how you reached Claim for costs of a child's funeral (for example from another website or a search engine)	6 months
